**AMENDMENT No. 3
TO THE
MEDICAL STUDENT EXCHANGE AGREEMENT
BY AND BETWEEN
THE UNIVERSITY OF JORDAN
AND
VANDERBILT UNIVERSITY**

This Amendment No. 3 serves to revise that certain Agreement entered into by and between the University of Jordan, Amman, Jordan (hereinafter referred to as "SCHOOL") and Vanderbilt University, a Tennessee not for profit corporation by and through its Vanderbilt University School of Medicine (hereinafter referred to as "VANDERBILT") (the "Agreement").

The Agreement is amended as follows:

1. Section I.C. **RESPONSIBILITIES OF SCHOOL 7.a.** is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

"In accordance with recommendations from the Centers for Disease Control ("CDC"), a two-step TB skin test is required. Student must provide written documentation of two (2) TB skin tests done within one year of the start date of the clinical, one of which needs to be within the past 3 months. If the second TB skin test is positive, a baseline chest X-ray will be required. Thereafter, a TB skin test will be performed annually."

2. Section II. **TERM and TERMINATION** is hereby amended to add a sentence to the end of the 1st paragraph to read:


"This Agreement shall be extended to terminate on June 30, 2012 unless the period of performance is extended by mutual written agreement."

3. **Appendix B** is deleted in its entirety and replaced with "Appendix B" attached hereto and made a part hereof by this reference.


Except as provided herein, the terms and conditions of the Agreement and any subsequent amendments are not further amended and shall remain in full force and effect.
